

IBM SPSS Statistics<sup>®</sup> 20  
Windows Installation  
Instructions (Site License)

These instructions are for installing IBM SPSS Statistics for Windows using a site license. A site license allows you to install SPSS Statistics for Windows on as many computers as the number of licenses you purchased. This document is for end users who are installing SPSS Statistics for Windows on desktop computers.

**Before starting installation, be sure your system date is correct.**  
Changing the system date after installation may make your license invalid.

**After installation, be sure to install latest patches.** See "Problems, Bugs, . . ." for more info.

System Requirements for IBM SPSS Statistics

- Operating System**
- Microsoft Windows XP (32-bit), Vista (32 or 64 bit), or Windows 7 (32 or 64 bit).
- Hardware Configuration**
- Intel or AMD processor, i3/i5 or higher.
  - 1 GB of RAM or more.
  - 800 MB of available hard-disk space.
  - Super VGA (1024x768) or a higher resolution monitor.
- Software**
- Internet Explorer 6.0

You will also need your authorization code, which you should have received from OIT. It activates your license for Basic, Advanced and Regression products. If you licensed any additional products directly from IBM you will also have additional authorization codes for those products. You will need all of your authorization codes to complete installation for all licensed products.

Note: You cannot run IBM SPSS Statistics remotely via Windows Terminal Services or Citrix.

Download

POWER, to install the IBM SPSS Statistics 20 program for Windows. You also need to download the IBM SPSS Statistics 20 license file that is required to use IBM SPSS Statistics 20. The next few pages describe how to download and install IBM SPSS Statistics 20. Downloading and installing IBM SPSS Statistics 20.2 for Windows If you are downloading a trial version of IBM SPSS Statistics 20.2, then the IBM SPSS Statistics 20 license file is already on your computer. If you are downloading a regular copy of IBM SPSS Statistics 20.2, then download the file to a folder that you can use later to store it. You must place the copy of the IBM SPSS Statistics 20 license file into the same folder as the IBM SPSS Statistics 20 program. Note: If you previously installed IBM SPSS Statistics 20.2, then you can uninstall it using the Web Start command. 1.Go to and on the Web page that appears, click the Download link. This will open a new browser window. 2.Copy and paste the POWER file to the folder on your computer that you want to use to store it. Do not use the download folder that was created when you installed the IBM SPSS Statistics 20 program. 3.If you do not see the POWER file in the download folder, then you may need to search your browser history to find the URL address. Open your browser history and look for the POWER file. 4.You can skip the next step if the POWER file is already in your download folder. 5.Press the OK button to start downloading the IBM SPSS Statistics 20 program. The size of the POWER file depends on the version of Windows that you are using, your Internet speed, and the speed of your computer. In general, the larger the file size, the faster the download speed. 6.When the IBM SPSS Statistics 20 program starts downloading, you will see the following message: The file has been added to your download folder. You can now start IBM SPSS Statistics 20. When you open the program, the IBM SPSS Statistics 20 help file opens automatically. Note: The link in this message opens a new browser window so that you can open a help 82157476af
